- Increased helium distribution costs due to greater amount of helium imports from the Middle East and Europe.

Due to these unprecedented changes, we will be increasing prices on bulk and packaged helium on July 1, 2019. Your new prices will be as follows:

HE 100LT	\$1,631.18
HE 250 LT	\$4,077.94
